#### Manager's Message

Happy New Year to all. We want to welcome all returning and new residents to Trails End whether you are coming for a short time or we are your winter destination. The New Year 2018 is upon us and we wish for good health and good times for all.

We are taking RV reservations for the winter of 2018/2019 so if you want to renew your current site, please stop by the office to secure it. We call this "Closed Season Reservations." Open season (reservations for a different site) will begin March 1, 2018. We ask for a \$200.00 deposit when reserving.

We ask that everyone be aware of their surroundings in the park especially after dark as we have some golf carts without lights being driven at that time. We have stressed this issue before but as a reminder, if you do not have lights on your golf cart, you SHOULD NOT be driving them on our park roads. We don't want to require everyone to have lights and ask for your cooperation in this matter, if you want or need assistance in installing light on your carts, come see the office for recommendations.

The January bills are ready in the office and want to remind everyone that we have a drop box in front of the office for payments made after hours or on weekends. The \$10.00 rent increase took effect January 1, 2018. Bills are due on the first of every month. We do have a grace period of up to the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month but at 4:00pm on the 10<sup>th</sup> a late fee of \$25.00 is generated automatically by the computer. If you are ever in question about your account status, feel free to see us at the office.

We want to thank all of you pet owners for you and your pet's cooperation and continued attention to this matter. Please let us know if the pet stations are empty of bags so we can refill them.
